

40 DAYS OF MIRACLE FAITH LIFE GROUP LESSON (WEEK 5) LIVING WITH A MIRACLE FAITH PERSPECTIVE

Memory verse: “*Don't be afraid the prophet answered. Those who are with us are more than those who are with them.*” (2 Kings 6:16)

Questions

1. This week we learned that often miracle faith begins with an adjustment of our perspective and attitude. We saw that before the servant could receive a miracle, he was invited to look at the situation from God's point of view. He had to let God “flip the script” of what he was assuming and believing.

Do you have a testimony of a situation where God helped you have a different perspective that led to a greater victory and more blessings in your life? How have things like gratitude, praise, and remembering God's promises helped you in this?
2. What is one thing that really stood out to you in this weeks story in 2 Kings 6:13-23? Recently, have you been in a situation where you felt surrounded by negativity? How might the lessons in this story help you respond?
3. What area do you especially feel you need to ask God to help you with perspective and attitude today?
 - Self-worth and how you look at yourself, especially considering your struggles, failures, what others have said about you and how you are tempted to compare yourself...
 - Circumstances that seem hopeless...
 - Areas you feel disappointed because there seems to be no progress...
 - People in your life, who are very difficult for you to handle and cope with...
 - Other...
4. Consider how you might reframe or reimagine that situation. What would it look like if you saw God between you and the problem instead of seeing the problem between you and God? As an activation try writing or describing your most difficult situation from a different perspective.
5. Which of the following declarations might be most important for you to speak regarding the current state of your life?
 - God and I are a majority in whatever situation I face. *Greater is He that is in me than he that is in the world.*
 - *Those who are with us* (including angelic forces) *are greater than those who are against us.*
 - There is always a solution to every problem. God will not ever let me be brought to a problem that He hasn't already provided a way through that problem through Him. *I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.*
 - I don't wait until situations improve to have joy; I claim joy in the middle of my situation. *The joy of the Lord is my strength.*
 - Wherever there is a closed door right now there is also an open window.
 - I believe *I will see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living.*
 - The outcomes of my life are not going to be determined by luck, circumstances, other people; they will be determined by God.
 - I don't look and judge people according to what I see; I choose to look at people according to their potential in God.
 - When I look in the mirror, I choose to see the person that God sees.
