(Jn. 15:15, I Cor. 1:4, Heb. 4:16)
4. I have overcome the world because He who lives within me is greater than any problem or need. (I John 4:4)
5. I have overcome Satan by the word of my testimony and the blood of the Lamb.
(Rev. 12:11)
6. The Lord is my shepherd. I do not lack. The Lord is my healer; by His stripes I am healed. The Lord is with me, I fear no evil. I walk in wisdom; I have the mind of Christ.
(Ps. 23:1-4, Ex. 15:26, I Pet. 2:24, Heb. 13:5, James 1:5, I Cor. 2:16)
7. My children are all taught of the Lord, great is the peace of my children. (Isa. 54:13)
8. I have a living hope and an eternal home. He who has begun a good work in me is faithful to complete it. (I Pet. 1:3-5, Jn. 14:2, Phil. 1:3-6)
9. I am an ambassador of Christ called and anointed to do the very works of Christ on earth. By God's grace I can preach the gospel, cast out demons, lay hands on the sick and expect them to recover. I am salt and light, a living epistle of Christ called to glorify God and reconcile people unto Him.
(Jn. 20:21, Mark 16:15-17, Mt. 5:13-14, II Cor. 3:2-6, Jn. 14:12, II Cor. 5:18-20)
10. Christ is my life; it is not I but Christ who lives in me.
I am a partaker of the divine nature, and God has given me all sufficiency in all things to abound in every good work. (Col. 3:4, Gal. 2:20, II Pet. 1:4, II Cor. 9:8)
11. The Lord anoints my head with oil, my cup overflows, goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever. (Ps. 23:5-6)
