3. God forgave David but did not take away the consequences of his actions. What do we learn about God from this truth?
4. How do you respond when others confront or correct you? Are you like Saul, who likes to rationalize, hide, and offer excuses. Or are you like David who owns your bad choices, and failures and then give them completely to God in repentance?

Action Step:

Do you have an accountability partner. One you could trust enough to share your heart including your weaknesses and sins? Would you prayerfully consider having one?
