“A new Name and a New Mission”

Key Verse: I have made you a light for the Gentiles, That you may bring salvation to the end of the earth. Acts 13:47

Key Thought: Things are becoming clearer. God is connecting the dots. His plan to bring us back to himself is now being realized. What God had planned since the Garden of Eden is now being realized, “Bring my People back to me”. Now the message of Hope, found in Jesus, was being spread all over the world, and it starts with the Apostle Paul.

Ice Breaker Question:

Do you have a favorite movie? What makes it your favorite movie?

Discussion Questions:

1. Why is Paul’s mission still the mission of Jesus for the church today? Do you see Jesus’ mission as your mission where you are placed today?
2. Paul faced many spiritual battles and attacks. (Acts 13: 1-12, Acts 16: 16-34, The Story Page 407-408, 412-413) What battles or attacks might we face as we bring the message of Hope to our world?
3. Paul tailored his message to each audience that he spoke to. The Gentiles had no previous knowledge of God as the Israelites had. Have you taken the step to share your testimony with others? Did you tailor your message to each person or group that you spoke with?
4. The church is a body and every member has a specific part with a specific function. (1 For. 12) What is your specific function? What is your Spiritual Gift? (Equip 301) How are you developing it?

5. Which "Fruit of the Spirit" (Gal. 5:22, The Story pg. 431) do you desire to see grow in your life? Have your Life Group pray as you seek to grow in this area.
