Memory Verse: *“...as the Father has sent me, so I am sending you.” John 20:21*

Discussion Questions:

1. Give a silly example of a time when you and another person completely misunderstood each other, and one of you had to say, “I didn’t say that!”
2. What is your first reaction hearing the statement, “God helps those who help themselves”?
